

KANSAS - BIG WHITETAILS - Hunt # 99



Anyone who pays attention and disregards the hype of the TV shows and DVD's, and who has experience in the trenches chasing after true trophy whitetails, knows that taking any whitetail in the 150 and above class is a very tough undertaking, no matter where you go and who you hunt with! Truth! Still, some outfits do a pretty good job in taking deer in that bracket with consistency. We do not mean one or two or three a year, but a goodly number every year! This outfit is one of that rare breed. In 2009 this outfit took 19 bucks and the average size was 151" !!!! Largest was 186." The year before, in 2008, their average was 158" for 14 bucks!! . Largest was 189" ! These are bucks taken by both bow and gun hunters. And for 2010 they will lease over 13,000 acres for whitetail hunting. They use both box and ground blinds, plus ladder and hang-on treestands. Our own clients have repeatedly told us they were hard workers with good equipment and they all said they would recommend the hunt to their best friend!! Many have said they think most clients should see 140 and 150 class bucks with a chance at much larger. Of course, ofthen the very large bucks were seen but not harvested! His bow hunters take some outstanding deer during the rut as do the gun hunters later. Stands are well placed and in good condition. He has nearly 90 ladder stands in place!! That is over \$10,000 worth of stands! This provides each hunter with fresh land to hunt. We think that a 150 class or better is a reasonable possibility if you pass the 130's and 140's and have a bit of luck! This gives bucks a chance to hit that 3 to 5 year old bracket. Again, not everyone is going to see or kill a big buck here, but the odds are very good! Nice farmhouse and cabins and good food! Fly to Kansas City, then it's about a 90 minute drive- rent a car- or pickup can be arranged for a \$75 fee each way. Apply in April for deer tags @ \$322.50 on line. No paper applications.
